We are a member of the social welfare organisation of Germany's Protestant churches (Diakonisches Werk). 

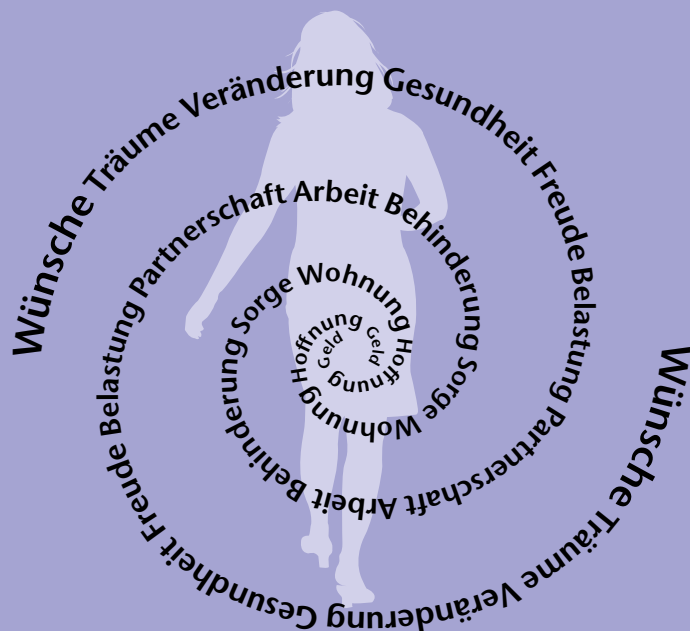

# Assistance for Pregnant Women

Pregnancy and child birth are dramatic events which can also lead to financial demands. The foundation awards funds from the Federal Foundation "Mother and child – Protection of Unborn Life" to pregnant women who require financial support.

## When can the foundation help?

- when difficult financial circumstances arise
- when all private and statutory forms of assistance have been exhausted

## How does the foundation help?

The foundation's funds are earmarked for:

- maternity wear
- supplementary baby equipment
- child-oriented furnishings and
- other assistance

## Where can you apply for help?

Applications for the foundation's services for pregnant women are generally made via the information centre for pregnancy. The application must be filed **before** the child birth.

The information centres will help you make your application and will forward the application to the foundation.
